A unique Gurudakshina by an ex-student, Shri Virendra Mhaiskar

" We asked for a flower, and got a whole garden!", this is how Dr. Jayashree Menon described the generosity and the social commitment of Virendra D Mhaiskar, on the eve of inauguration of a new seven-storeyed building of Model School in Dombivli East.

Born in Dombivli and educated in Model English School, Dr. Jayashree Menon, a Ph.D holder, now works as a Lecturer in Maharashtra College, Mumbai Central. A multi-faceted and versatile personality, Jayashree Menon hails from Thrissur and is actively involved, like her

parents, in the activities of Keraleeya Samajam, Dombivli. The Model English School managed by Keraleeya Samajam is one of the top schools in the district and can rightly boast of nourishing many a talent like Jayashree Menon and Virendra Mhaiskar.

The newly built 7-storeyed building at Pandurangwadi in Dombivli East, is, in fact, Virendra Mhaiskar's 'Gurudakshina' to his Alma Mater. The old school building where he had studied was demolished and in its place a brand new high-school building with all modern

facilities, costing Rs 27 crore, was built and entrusted to the Keraleeya Samajam by Shri Mhaiskar.

In 2015, the then Chairman of Keraleeya Samajam approached a few ex students including Dr.Jayashree with an idea and mission to rise funds for refurbishing the old building. Dr. Jayashree suggested the name of her classmate, Shri. Virendra Mhaiskar, Chairman and MD of IRB Infrastructure

Excerpts from the interview

Sir, you joined MES in STD 4th. Was it your demand or a decision taken by your parents? What prompted this decision?

I think it's destiny that decides. My mother was not happy with the school I was going and she learnt that MES was the best option even in those days and then my dad got it touch with the school management to get the admission for me in MES In fact, they changed my school mid term and I joined MES from second term of 4th standard.

When I joined I attended the school premise that worked out of Baji Prabhu chowk and then from 5th standard shifted to the Pandurang wadi school premise

Any notable memories of your school life? Do share some nostalgic moments of your school days.

I was a shy person then and usually a mid path follower, but the school certainly brought out the best in me and surely made me a confident person to face the outside world by the time I completed my std 10th I can still remember the strict discipline that the school persuaded. While many children did not like it, the discipline was deeply ingrained into our DNA and has certainly helped in the long term tackling the rigours of daily life.

Until standard 8th I used to take shared rickshaw to school.I still remember paying 50



paise one way then and the rickshaw guy used to put at least 8-10 of us in one rickshaw and drive us to school.The part i enjoyed most was when I got my own bicycle in the last two years of school when I used to take it to school all the way from our house in Dombivli West. Those were the best years to my mind where we friends rode the cycle together back and forth to the school.

Are you still in touch with your school mates? It is said that friendship made in school life lasts lifelong. How true is it in your case?

It's very correct ! It does last lifelong.I am certainly in touch with many of my friends who are now spread across the globe and have done well for themselves. Some are engineers, some are doctors, some are lawyers or chartered accountants and all doing great in their own fields.

I keep meeting them to the best of my abilities.

As a child, what were your aspirations? Can you tell us about the driving force for taking up this career and a brief description about your journey to success?

Thanks to my mother, I read a lot of history and that somehow imbibed in me the quality to lead from the front.

I had a clear aspiration that I would want to set up my own business.

In a nutshell, the journey has been from “ 0 “ to “75,000 “ crores asset base in 25 years!

Dr. Jayashree Menon

Dr. Jayashree Menon was born and brought up in Dombivli.

Studied in Model English school. Passed out in 1987. Further, did her B. Sc., M. Sc, B. Ed and Ph. D from University of Mumbai.

Dr. Jayashree was good in academics throughout her student career and has been a recipient of several scholarships till her Ph.D degree. She was a second rank holder in both B.Sc. and M. Sc. in her subject Zoology in University of Mumbai.

Being a multi talented student, good in dance, drawing, literature and sports, she was popular in school. Her friendly approach and helping nature made her favourite among students and teachers.

She was recipient of CCRT (an undertaking of NCERT, New Delhi) scholarship for Bharatanatyam for 7 years. She was awarded with Rashtrapati puraskar, the highest merit for Scouts and Guides too.

She was one of the choreographers and coordinators of the Mahakaikottikali event organised by Mumbai Pooram Foundation in 2012 which found its place in the Guinness book of records for the largest number of participants.

Dr Jayashree has 18 research papers to her credit. She has also written 4 books for primary children because she believes values has to be inculcated right from early childhood.

She is also the coordinator and advisor of her 35 year old family run Institute, Jai nursery & junior KG classes.

Even after passing out, she continued to keeping contacts with her teachers and classmates and had taken initiative to organise reunions of classmates regularly. Her involvement with Keraleeya Samajam is right from her birth as she recalls.

Both her parents were actively involved in

KSD activities. Her father Late P. Sudhakaran served Samajam in various capacities: as Committee member for several years, then as Vice President, President and Vice Chairman. He is known for his sincerity and dedication to the work allotted to him. Mother Late Hymavathi Sudhakaran still rules the hearts of many in Dombivli for her selfless love showered to the people around her.

Inheriting these qualities, Dr. Jayashree Menon also had been involved in Samajam activities mainly in the Arts and Cultural section in the beginning. Participating in cultural programmes, choreographing and performing dance, anchoring events, organising various programmes is what she enjoyed. She was a member of the Arts and Cultural committee in 2000 and education sub committee from 2015 to 2022. She was appointed as a member of the 'Academic Council of Model College', Dombivli in 2020 and still continues to be in the council. She is also the member of 'College Development Committee' of Model College since 2022.

She was an active member of KSD women's wing since 2016 and has served as a Coordinator of Pandurangwadi 1 area and as Secretary of KSWW for 4 years. Along with her team, she could start various programmes for the empowerment of women.

Apart from Keraleeya Samajam, she is also associated with a few other social organisations through which she continues serving the needy in whichever way she can.

Professionally, she is working as a Biology Lecturer at Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Mumbai Central for the last 25 years.

A Journey to success ! It can be attributed largely to taking up the “road less travelled “. It did have its own set of problems but financial discipline and focus on execution helped us through.

Keraleeya Samajam approached you for a contribution for the redevelopment of the old school. You offered them to build the entire building. What made you take up such a mega project? What was your motivation?

In fact it was my class mate Jayashree menon



who got in touch with me. She had been working closely with the school management on this idea. She broached up the subject with me and wanted me to see the project. When the school management came along with her to our office and presented the project, I realized that such massive project with token contribution collection may take years to complete and considering cost escalations can land into tricky situations.

I also looked upon it as a great opportunity to give back to the institution that moulded my early life. God has been kind and we had the wherewithal to support such project

Hence I offered them to take up the entire project funding. This proved very useful, particularly during the Covid pandemic as we ensured funding support all through and the project progressed relentlessly. The final cost did undergo escalation but we decided to stay on course and funded that as well.

After this first meeting with management of MES in September 2015, you were able to reconnect with your Alma mater and classmates... is it true?

Yes. After conversing with Jayashree, I could connect with many schoolmates and learn about their whereabouts. I even attended the Alumni get-together organized as a part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations of MES in December 2015. During this event, I had the chance to visit my school after almost 28 years. It was indeed an overwhelming experience to sit

on the benches with our classmates in our old classrooms and revive old memories.

Your brainchild, IRB Infrastructure Developers Ltd. has emerged as India's pioneering and largest infrastructure company in the highway sector. How did you achieve this?

The credit of this goes to team IRB. Our integrated approach of developing knowhow and expertise across the value chain very much helped us. In infrastructure projects, controlling cost overruns and timely completion are key to success and we very much stuck to those principles. Also adopting newer financing methods like introducing infrastructure Investment trusts and collaboration with right partners also helped a lot. Government of Singapore's sovereign wealth fund GIC and US headquartered Ferrovial group are two large investors in IRB today and also on board of the company / trust

What are the major projects taken up by IRB ? Please tell us about your ongoing projects also.

Today IRB portfolio spans across 12 States and covers a length of almost 18500 lane kms .

We cater to more than 1.15 million vehicles a day across our toll booths.

The portfolio comprises of 25 projects. Few of the large ones include the Mumbai Pune Expressway, Hyderabad Outer Ring Road.

We are also building a part of the Ganga expressway and Delhi Mumbai Expressway.

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Education and health are two sectors where IRB has been focusing and has made significant contributions to the society in

both. Other than Model English School, which are your other CSR projects: completed and ongoing ?

In health care, the project closest to us is our collaboration with our MES ex student and renowned Oncologist Dr Anil Heroor to whom we have provided fully equipped mammography vans for early diagnosis of cancer in tribal people in remote areas.

In education field IRB owns and operates two schools in remote part of Rajasthan and Punjab imparting free education to more than 800 students.

Any piece of advice to the new generation? Students, in particular, would like to hear from you.

I feel the present school going generation is very smart and in tune with the current environment.

The only thing they need to sharpen is discipline and focus. This will certainly help them in long run. Also, they should pursue whichever field they choose, with full passion.

What aspects should school management focus upon? Comment on the present system of education in India. As a successful

businessman, what kind of changes would you like in the education system?

The education system in India has certainly progressed a lot. However if it can be made more focused on developing skills, it will help the students more. The education they get should be more usable in daily walks of life. It should be more practical oriented. The interactive digital experience that we have brought in to the new school building will certainly help the students in this regards.

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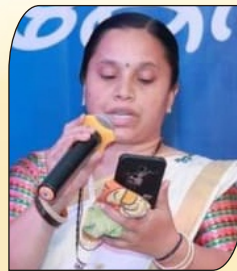
